

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION

GRANTHAM AND BOURNE CONSTITUENCY

1. An election is to be held of a Member of Parliament to serve Grantham and Bourne Constituency.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Acting Returning Officer, South Kesteven House, Civic Building, St. Peter's Hill, Grantham, NG31 6PY during the times stated below.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer at the South Kesteven House, Civic Building, St. Peter's Hill, Grantham, NG31 6PY on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday 10am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays) but no later than **4pm on Friday 7 June 2024**.
4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender, banker's draft from a drawer who carries on business as banker in the United Kingdom or by online bank transfer. The Acting Returning Officer will give further details on request.
5. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on **Thursday, 4 July 2024**.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on **Tuesday 18 June 2024**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
7. New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 19 June 2024**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote>.
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on **Wednesday 26 June 2024**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-to-vote>.
9. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday, 26 June 2024**. Some applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>.
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Thursday, 4 July 2024**.
