

COMMENTING ON A PLANNING APPLICATION

Visit our website at www.southkesteven.gov.uk/planning-building-control.

Log in to view applications, or click 'Register' to set up an account. You will not be able to comment on applications unless you are logged in.

To search for an application Click on 'Search', 'Planning' and then click on your preferred search option. Enter the planning application number you wish to view, or you can search based on other criteria, eg. address, street name, town/village etc.
