

## LICENSING ACT 2003 Notice of Application for a Minor Variation

The premises has been utilising the Business & Planning Act 2020 provision for off-sales and following the updated guidance issued under Section 182 dated February 2025, would like to apply for the continuation of off-sales via a minor variation, as stated within Section 8.65.
